KidCare: For Any Child Without Health Insurance

Ninety percent of families in Florida have health insurance for their children. But if your child does not have health insurance, Florida KidCare can help.

Florida KidCare provides health care benefits for children under the age of 19. Children in the program have access to care such as regular doctor visits, immunizations and dental and vision benefits. Most families pay twenty dollars or less per month. Many families pay nothing at all for their children to be covered.
