

Special Teen Outreach Program



Being a teenage girl in today's world means being faced with many challenges on a daily basis. Our program has trained care coordinators who are ready to help teens face those challenges and learn how to make informed decisions regarding developing healthy relationships, planning for education, sexual activity, good nutrition and regular physical activity.

STOP provides a one on one intensive experience for the teen. We work to develop a meaningful relationship so that the care coordinator becomes a trusted adult who acts as a mentor and a coach. For that reason we ask that each teen make a commitment to meet with her care coordinator at least three times.
